



MARINE SAFETY ZONES DURING A ROCKET LAB LAUNCH

Listen on VHF 79 for 24/7 launch updates and information

Call RANGE CONTROL on VHF 07 or 16 and report

- Vessel name
 Destination
- Time planned clear of area

ALL vessels MUST be clear of the zone

BEFORE 15:00 (3:00pm)

Unless permission granted directly by RANGE CONTROL or launch scrubbed for the day

The immediate area around Black Reef is inside the zone. See the chart for details. To be certain, check your GPS! Simple safe areas on the western coast are:


West of 177° 47' E or North of 39° 13' S


