SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS AND REGULATIONS:

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. Complete and upload this application form to the application portal on our website.
- 2.A Selection Committee within Rocket Lab will assess the applications and contact a shortlist of applications.
- 3. The Selection Committee will then interview candidates.
- 4. The Scholarship will be awarded to the successful candidate.

REGULATIONS:

- 1. The Scholarship shall be known as the Rocket Lab Women's Scholarship
- 2. The Scholarship will be awarded annually to a student who:
 - a. Is a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident; and
 - b. Is scheduled to begin tertiary study towards a degree in science, engineering or technology in 2023; and
 - c. Who identifies as female or non-binary.
- 3. The Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:
 - a. Demonstration of passion for science, technology or engineering
 - b. Involvement in cultural, community, or leadership activities
 - Quality of character and indication that the scholarship would provide a meaningful positive impact.
- 4.One Scholarship will be awarded annually, to the value of up to \$10,000, which may be used towards course fees or course related costs.
- 5. The Scholarship will be reviewed by a Selection Committee within Rocket Lab, and will be awarded by Rocket Lab's CEO, Peter Beck.
- 6.Rocket Lab has the power to amend or vary these regulations provided that there is no departure from the main purpose of the Scholarship.
- 7. The Scholarship recipient may receive opportunities for mentorship from Rocket Lab's team or wider connections.
- 8.Rocket Lab has the right to publish the names and photographs of successful scholars in news media and via Rocket Lab's own website and external channels.
- 9. The selection committee may refrain from awarding the scholarship if, in their opinion, there is no applicant of sufficient merit.

NOTES:

- 1. Students who have been offered the Scholarship must meet all requirements for admission to their programme of study and demonstrate proof of enrollment before scholarship funds are paid to the student.
- 2. The student will be required to pay all other fees and costs not covered by the Scholarship.
- 3. Rocket Lab may at any time suspend or terminate a Scholarship if the applicant is not meeting the academic requirements of their university programme.
